Penamonte Blanco Toro 2009 This Spanish wine is 100% Verdejo. Excellent with Fish and Shellfish. It has an intense aroma with a touch of tropical fruit. The palate is sweet, exotic and fruity.	19.50
Terret – Laroche 2008/09 Well-made firm Dry wine from the little-known grape variety Terret. No Flashy aromatics, simply modern, well-structured without oak.	19.50
De Gras Reserva – 2008/09 A class Sauvignon Blanc from Chile, not to be Confused with a Non – Reserva.	21.50
Villa Solais – Vermentino 2009 Sardinia's best known white, this golden coloured, dry wine is aromatic, displaying light almond flavours and a fresh well balanced finish.	21.50
Mas Saint Laurent – 2008/09 What do the French drink with Fish and Shellfish in the Languedoc? Picpoul de Pinet. This classy version is Dry with a Fruity edge.	21.50
De Gras Reserva Viognier 2009/10 From the Colchagua Valley in Chile this Quality wine is Dry with Ripe Peach and Apricot Aromas.	22.00
Amaral Chardonnay 2007/08 This wine from Chile's newest and most radical climate area is described as 'Whites from the Edge'. It is Light Gold in colour, Creamy texture and well balanced with very good Length.	22.50

Veramonte – Cabernet Sauvignon 2008/09 This wine from Chile's Premium Wine Estate, has a Deep Rich Flavour with Spicy Fruit. The result is a deliciously smooth wine.	21.50
Bodegas Navajas, Rioja 2008/09 The hallmark characteristics of Rioja comes from maturing the wine in oak barrels resulting in hints of vanilla and 'floor polish' notes. An impressive structured Rioja with enough juicy red berry fruit to make this wine very balanced.	22.50
Château des Gravières Cuvée Prestige 2005/06 From a small chateau in the graves area of Bordeaux, it is aged in barrique, has good balance with fine fruit and deep colour.	26.00
Simon Hackett Shiraz, McLaren Vale 2006 This is really punchy Shiraz, with succulent, ripe blackberry fruit and hints of black pepper and spice. Mouthfilling and satisfying without being too heavy.	29.50
